SALISBURY ROTARY SCHOLARSHIPS

The Salisbury Rotary Club is offering a limited number of academic scholarships for Salisbury area students. The guidance counselors at your high school will have additional information.

QUALIFICATIONS

- A. The applicant shall be a resident of Rowan County, North Carolina, and must have been a resident for the two (2) years immediately prior to such filing of application.
- B. All applicants for grants will be considered equally without regard to the race, creed, color, national origin or financial need of the applicant.
- C. Grants may be used for the pursuit of study at any college or university or any technical or community college in or out of the State of North Carolina.
- D. The following are not eligible:
 - 1. A Rotarian (either active or inactive);
 - 2. A former Rotarian who has resigned within five (5) years prior to submitting an application;
 - 3. An employee of a club, a district or other Rotary entity, or Rotary International;
 - 4. A spouse, lineal descendant (child or grandchild by blood and any legally adopted child), a spouse of a lineal descendant, or an ancestor (parent or grandparent by blood) of any person in the foregoing categories.
